



On November, 10th 2009 the **Minister of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation** of **Rwanda**, H.E. Rosemary Museminali, paid an official visit to Kattameya cement plant.

The Marketing and Sales Director of Suez Cement group of Companies (SCGC), Mr. Nabil Francis, briefed Minister Museminali on Italcementi Group's activities around the world focusing his presentation on the Egyptian cement market and thereby on SCGC's business.

Therefore, she expressed her interest in making cement available and affordable in Rwanda by providing full support to the investors that will be interested in building cement plants in Kigali.
